Adult French Beginner/Intermediate Reading Course

Wednesday Morning

Wednesdays, March 20 to May 22, 2019

The Adult French Beginner/Intermediate Reading Course will meet every Wednesday Morning, starting Wednesday, March 20 and go ten weeks (May 22, 2019), provided there are no make-up classes needed. Classes will be two hours at a time, from 10:00AM to 12:00PM, and will be held at 74 Brook Hill Road, Hamden. Safe parking is available in private driveway. Limited to maximum 6 students.

This course is designed to read excerpts from various French literature

and writings from different sources at an Easy Reader level.

Teacher as well as students will read out loud and analyze and discuss these texts in French.

Reading material will provided.

Prerequisite: Students should be able to read French and reasonably understand vocabulary of 1500 to 2000 words. The class is held in a friendly, non-judgmental atmosphere.

The instructor, Yvonne Kolodny, was born and educated in Switzerland where she concentrated in Business and French. She lived and worked a few years in Geneva prior to coming to the United States. Mrs. Kolodny started her teaching career with the world renowned Berlitz® School of Languages teaching and translating French. She was also the language learning methodology trainer for other teachers at the school. Besides teaching adults for more than two decades, she taught French Independent Studies for the Hamden High School and tutored students for the Cheshire High School and the Choate Rosemary school.
