Adult French Beginner 102
Mondays, March 18, to May 20, 2019

The Adult Beginner French 102 will meet every Monday, starting Monday, March 18, and go ten weeks until May 20, 2019 (provided no make-up classes needed).

Classes will be two hours at a time, from 5:45-7:45pm, and will be held at 74 Brook Hill Road, Hamden. Safe parking is available in private driveway. Limited to maximum 8 students.

This **Adult Beginner French 102** course will be taking off from the Fall 2018 French Beginner 1. This means, there will be a short review of the Beginner 1 course and then will continue with Chapter six in Barron's, Learn French the Fast and Fun way, and Chapter six in Pierre Capretz, French in Action Book. **This course is ideal for students who finished the French Adult Beginner 1 course or already have had some prior French instruction and experience. Some students might want to take this course to do review work from former classes with us.** - With Barron's Learn French the Fast and Fun way, we will continue to learn to talk about people, friends, your family. You will be handling simple business transactions, learn about dining, entertainment, shopping. – The French in Action will immerse you into the French Culture and you will learn how to feel confident and relaxed in a French environment. This course will be increasingly taught in French, Grammar will increasingly cover more verb forms and language structure.
