**Adult French Beginner 103**  
**Tuesdays, March 19 to May 21, 2019**

**The Adult French Beginner 103** will meet every Tuesday, starting Tuesday, March 19, and go for ten weeks . (May, 21, 2019, if no make-up classes are needed). Classes will be two hours at a time, from 5:45-7:45pm, and will be held at 74 Brook Hill Road, Hamden. Safe parking is available in private driveway. Limited to maximum 8 students.

This course is a continuation of French Beginner 2 and we will mostly work in the program **French in Action** by **Pierre Capretz**, starting with Chapter 10. This course is ideal for students with prior knowledge of French, or who would like to continue from the previous course or who even have taken this course before but would like to refresh and intensify their skills. This course is conducted mainly in French except for some grammar. All four language skills like listening, speaking, reading and writing will be practiced and homework will be assigned.

*Videos to French in Action are easily accessible online. These videos also touch on grammar and vocabulary. If you watch videos 10 and 11 and feel comfortable to follow, this course is for you.*
