Adult French Beginner 103
Thursdays, February 27, until May 7, 2020

The Adult French Beginner 103 will meet every Thursday, starting February 27, and go until May 7, 2020 provided there are no make-up days. There will be no class on Thursday, March 19, 2020. Classes will be two hours at a time, from 5:45-7:45pm, and will be held at 74 Brook Hill Road, Hamden. Safe parking is available in private driveway. Class is Limited to maximum 8 students.

This course is a continuation of French Beginner 102 and we will work mostly with the program **French in Action by Pierre Capretz, starting** with Chapter 17. This course is ideal for students who either would like to continue from the previous course or who have studied some French before and would like to refresh and intensify their skills. This course is conducted partly in French. All four language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing will be practiced and homework will be assigned.

Videos to French in Action are easily accessible online. These videos also touch on grammar and vocabulary. If you watch videos 15 and 16 and feel comfortable to follow, this course is for you.
