**Overview of Adult Beginner 3 Fall Course**

**The Adult Beginner3 French Class** will meet every Thursday, starting Thursday, September 6 and go 10 weeks . (no class November 8). Classes will be two hours at a time, from 5:45-7:45pm, and will be held at 74 Brook Hill Road, Hamden. Safe parking is available in private driveway. Limited to maximum 8 students.

In this course, we will concentrate on the popular program **French in Action by Pierre Capretz** and start from Chapter 11. (taking off from end of Beginner 2). Instruction will be conducted mainly in French except for some grammar. All four language skills like listening, speaking, reading and writing will be practiced and homework will be assigned.

Additional material from various sources adequate for this level will be introduced. This will increase oral fluency and build confidence with conversation. Grammar and Language Structure will be part of this course. The goal is to prepare you for the intermediate/ advanced level French. - This program will immerse you into the French Culture in a fun and relaxed atmosphere in order to feel confident and comfortable in a French speaking environment.
