

French 103: Thursdays, February 4, 2021 to March 25, 2021

This is an eight week Zoom Online Adult course at the Beginner Level 103. This class uses the **French in Action, Pierre Capretz®** program and is ideal for students who would either like to continue from the previous course, Beginner 102, or have studied some French earlier and would like to refresh and intensify their skills.

The **French in Action®** textbook is delightful and entirely in French, offering a great insight into the French culture. All videos are available online. **We will start with chapter 11.** If you watch a few previous chapters you will be able to decide if this level is for you.
