

## **French 101: Starting October 25, 2021 to November 29, 2021**

This is a Zoom Online Adult course at the Beginner Level 101. This class uses the by Yale designed **French in Action, Pierre Capretz®** program which introduces you to the French Language right from the start, and is used by many Universities. This delightful, entirely French textbook offers a great insight into the French culture. All videos are offered online. This helps students to listen, read and speak quickly and pick up many French idioms from the start.

In addition to the French in Action textbook, we use a traditional grammar and language structure book to help you achieve the goal of strengthening all four language skills: Reading – Writing – Listening – Speaking. Homework will be assigned.

Our classes are small and the atmosphere is friendly, non-judgmental and conducive for conversation.

**Classes will be two hours at a time, from 5:30PM -7:30PM EST on Mondays and run for six weeks. Starting day: October 25, 2021. A small break will help you stretch, grab a snack, and socialize with your fellow students. - Class sizes are limited in order to give everyone the optimum Zoom experience. This is an ideal medium where location, distance and inclement weather will be of no issue.**

The Ultimate French, Review and Practice, Passport Books. Preferably Premium third (or fourth) edition
