


Introductory French 101:February 2, 2021 to April 6, 2021



This is an introductory Zoom course into French for adults who have no prior experience and have never studied French before. In this Beginner course you will learn how to introduce yourself, exchange greetings, say the alphabet, count, tell time and ask questions. You will be able to talk about people, friends and family. More into the book you will also be handling simple business transactions, learn about dining, entertainment, shopping. **Most of all, you will be encouraged to speak French from the first lesson on.**

An introduction into grammar goes along with the course in an easy, fun way. – Homework will be assigned, but most of all the atmosphere is congenial and non-judgmental.

For this course we will use the book: **Barron's: Learn French the Fast and Fun way**, including MP3CD, **Fourth Edition: Barnes and Nobles or online**

Classes will be one hour per week from **12:30 PM to 1:30 PM** and run for 10 weeks, starting Tuesday, February 2, 2021. **Class size is limited** to give everyone the optimum Zoom und learning experience. Zoom is the ideal medium where location, distance and inclement weather will be of no issue.

The instructor, Yvonne Kolodny, was born and educated in Switzerland where she concentrated in Business and Languages . She lived and worked in Geneva prior to coming to the United States. Mrs. Kolodny started her teaching career with the world renowned **Berlitz® School of Languages** teaching and translating French. She trained other faculty in the Berlitz® Method of teaching. Besides instructing adults for over three decades, she taught the French Independent Studies for the Hamden High School and tutored students for the Cheshire High School and the Choate Rosemary Hall, Wallingford
